

ABSTRAK

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Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menganalisis perkembangan penelitian pasar modal syariah periode 2000-2024 menggunakan metode bibliometrik. Data dikumpulkan dari database Scopus dengan menggunakan kata kunci "*Islamic Capital Market*" OR "*Islamic Stock Market*". Kemudian dianalisis menggunakan perangkat lunak VOSviewer dan Biblioshiny. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa jumlah publikasi di bidang pasar modal syariah meningkat signifikan sejak tahun 2014, terutama setelah pandemi COVID-19 yang mendorong minat pada instrumen keuangan syariah sebagai alternatif yang stabil dan etis. Analisis bibliometrik mengungkapkan bahwa topik utama yang sering dibahas meliputi *islamic finance*, *sukuk*, *shariah compliance*, *covid-19*, *islamic index*, *conventional stock market*, *garch model* dll. Selain itu, penelitian ini menemukan adanya kolaborasi intensif diantara penulis dari berbagai negara, penelitian yang memiliki kesamaan referensi dan beberapa publikasi menjadi rujukan utama di bidang ini. Penelitian ini mengungkapkan adanya referensi yang sering dikutip bersama. Hasil penelitian ini menyarankan topik yang masih sedikit diteliti untuk dijadikan saran penelitian selanjutnya, meliputi *Sustainable Capital Market*, *Safe Haven*, *Geopolitical Risk*, *Data envelopment analysis*, dan sebagainya.

ABSTRACT

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Title : Bibliometric Analysis of the Development of Research on the Islamic Capital Market

This study aims to analyze the development of research on the Islamic capital market from 2000 to 2024 using the bibliometric method. Data were collected from the Scopus database using the keywords "Islamic Capital Market" OR "Islamic Stock Market." The data were then analyzed using VOSviewer and Biblioshiny software. The results show that the number of publications in the Islamic capital market field has increased significantly since 2014, especially after the COVID-19 pandemic, which spurred interest in Islamic financial instruments as a stable and ethical alternative. The bibliometric analysis reveals that the main topics frequently discussed include Islamic finance, sukuk, shariah compliance, COVID-19, Islamic index, conventional stock market, GARCH model, and others. Additionally, this study found intensive collaboration among authors from various countries, the presence of research with shared references, and several key publications that serve as primary references in this field. The study also highlights the existence of frequently co-cited references. The findings suggest several under-researched topics for future studies, including Sustainable Capital Market, Safe Haven, Geopolitical Risk, Data Envelopment Analysis, and others
