This research was conducted in Seumirah Village, Nisam Antara District, North Aceh Regency. This study aims to see how the role of village-owned enterprises (BUMG) in empowering farming in Seumirah Village, Nisam Antara District, North Aceh Regency. The method used in this study is a qualitative descriptive method with an analytical tool using a Likert scale. The sampling technique is using a census by taking all the farmers who are members of BUMG Beudoh Beusaree, namely as many as 15 people. The results showed that the role of village-owned enterprises (BUMG) in empowering farming in Seumirah Gampong was stated to have a role with an index value of 78.22%, using 3 indicators, namely human development, business development, and capital development.
