was carried out in Cane Toa Village, Rikit Gaib District, Gayo Lues Regency.

This research aims to find out the value of the income of family pine sap tappers

in Cane Toa Village, Rikit Gaib District, Gavo Lues Regency and to find out how

much the contribution of pine resin tapping income to families in Cane Toa

Village, Rikit Gaib District, Gavo Lues Regency. Data analysis method. obtained

were analyzed quantitatively and descriptively so as to obtain a systematic and

accurate picture. The results of this research show that the average

income/farmers' income from pine sap tappers in Cane Toa Village is IDR.

3,504,606.06/month with pine sap tapping costs of Rp. 219,514.83/production. So

you get a profit of Rp. 3,285,091.23/month which is able to increase the income of

the people in Cane Toa Village and the contribution of pine resin tapping income

to families in Cane Toa Village is 44.12% which is considered a good level of

contribution. This contribution was obtained from the average income/farmers

tapping pine sap Rp. 3,285,091.23 distributed with a total family income of Rp.

7,441,462.08/month.
