Long bean vegetable farming is an activity of cultivating long bean plants carried out by farmers, by utilizing production facilities by combining agricultural technology, with the hope of obtaining maximum profits from the farming carried out and obtaining income to meet living needs. This research was carried out in Padang Mirror Village, Complete District, Langkat Regency. This research aims to analyze the average income of farmers in Padang Cermin Village, Finish District, Langkat Regency, North Sumatra Province in farming long bean vegetables. The results of this research show that the average production of long beans produced by farmers in Padang Cermin Village in farming long bean vegetables is 2,125 kg/MT with an average selling price of long beans/kg of Rp. 4,577/MT, with an average income The amount obtained was IDR 9,726,125/MT, with the average total costs incurred being IDR 5,781,897/MT, with the average income of farmers in Padang Cermin Village in farming long bean vegetables amounting to IDR 3.356.564/MT. MT, and the results of this research show that long bean vegetable farming in Padang Cermin Village, Finish District is profitable and feasible to continue, this is proven by the R/C value of 1.58/MT.
