Data collection methods include observation, interviews, and documentation. Data analysis involves data reduction, data presentation, and drawing conclusions. The research results show that the pattern of primary communication within Batak Toba families is greatly influenced by openness and trust among family members. Effective communication in the family is characterized by the ability to listen actively, provide constructive feedback, and involve key figures in the extended family, such as traditional leaders and family members.
